1/2 Point Penalties:

- Tick or light touch of leg

1 Point Penalties:

- Hitting or touching leg

- Out of lead more than one stride either side of the center point and between markers

- Scuffing the leg (leg between the two feet or two hind feet) at the top

- Hock legs skidding or coming together during lead change

3 Point Penalties:

- Not performing the spade gal (log or lops) or not stopping when asked for the pattern, with 10 feet (3 meters) or the designated area

- Simple change of leads

- Out of lead at or before the marker prior to the designated change area or out of lead at or after the marker after the designated change area

- Additional lead changes anywhere in pattern (except when completing an extra change or backward lead)

- Pattern 1 and 3: failure to start the lops with 30 feet (9 meters) after crossing the log at the top

- Break of gait at walk or jog for more than two strides

- Break of gait at the lops

5 Point Penalties:

- Out of lead beyond the end designated change area (note: failure to change, including cross-leading. Two consecutive failures to change would result in two five point penalties)

- Stated disobedience including kicking out, biting, bucking and rearing

- Holding saddle with either hand

- Use of either hand to grasp tail or praise

Disqualification (DQ) or 0 Score:

- Illegal equipment

- Willful Abuse

- Off Course

- Knocking over markers

- Major refusal - stop and back more than two strides or four steps with bent legs

- Major disobedience or schooling

- Failure to start lops prior to end cone in Pattern 1

- Four or more simple lead changes and/or failures to change leads (except for Level 1 and Rookie classes)

- Failure to start lops beyond 30 feet of designated area in Patterns 2, 3, 4, 5 and Level 1 Western Riding Patterns 1, 2, and 4 (except for Level 1 classes)

- Duration of more than 1:34 time

Each horse and/or team is scored between 0-100 points and automatically begins the run with a score of 75 points

1/2 Point Penalties:

- Tick or light touch of log

1 Point Penalties:

- Hitting or using log

- Out of lead more than one stride either side of the center point and between markers

- Spitting the log (log between the two front or two hind feet) at the log

- Head fags slipping or coming together during lead change

3 Point Penalties:

- Not performing the specific gait (log or fags) or not stopping when called for the pattern, with 10 feet (3 meters) of the designated change area

- Simple change of leads

- Out of lead at or before the marker prior to the designated change area or out of lead at or after the marker after the designated change area

- Additional lead changes anywhere in pattern (except when correcting an extra change or incorrect lead)

- Pattern 1 and 3: failure to start the lope with 30 feet (9 meters) after crossing the log at the log

- Break of gait at work or log for more than two strides

- Break of gait at the lope

5 Point Penalties:

- Out of lead beyond the next designated change area (note: failures to change, including cross-centering. Two consecutive failures to change would result in two five point penalties.)

- Alarm disobedience including flying out, biting, bucking and rearing

- Holding saddle with either hand

- Use of either hand to assist in or penalize

Disqualification (DQ) or 0 Score:

- Illegal equipment

- Willful Abuse

- Off Course

- Knocking over markers

- Major refusal - stop and back more than two strides or four steps with front legs

- Major disobedience or schooling

- Failure to start lope prior to and occur in Pattern 1

- Four or more simple lead changes and/or failures to change leads (except for Level 1 and Rock's classes)

- Failure to start lope beyond 30 feet of designated area in Patterns 2, 3, 4, 5 and Level 1 Western Riding Patterns 1, 2, and 4 (except for Level 1 classes)

- Duration of more than 1 1/2 hrs.

MANEUVER SCORES

Each horse rider begins in speed between 8-100 pairs and automatically begins the run with a score of 76 points
 -3 1/2 Extremely Poor, -1 Very Poor, -1/2 Poor, 0 Correct, +1/2 Good, +1 Very Good, +3 1/2 Excellent

1/2 Point Penalties:

- Tick or light touch of leg

1 Point Penalties:

- Hiding or no leg fog

- Out of lead more than one stride either side of the center point one between markers

- Splitting the leg (leg between the two front or two hind feet) at the top

- Hind legs skipping or coming together during lead change

3 Point Penalties:

- Not performing the specified gait (leg or lope) or not stopping when called for the pattern, with 30 feet (9 meters) or the designated area

- Simple change of leads

- Out of lead at or before the marker prior to the designated change area, or out of lead at or after the marker after the designated change area

- Additional lead changes anywhere in pattern (except when correcting an extra change or incorrect lead)

- Pattern 1 and 3; failure to sign the legs within 30 feet (9 meters) after crossing the top all the leg

- Break of gait at walk or leg for more than two strides

- Break of gait at the lope

5 Point Penalties:

- Out of lead beyond the next designated change area (note: failures to change, including cross-cutting. Two consecutive failures to change would result in two five point penalties)

- Failure to acknowledge incoming kicking out, cutting, bucking or rearing

- Holding saddle with either hand

- Use of other hand to hold lead or praise

Disqualification (DQ) or 0 Score:

- Illegal equipment

- Whip Abuse

- On Course

- Knocking over markers

- Major refusal - stop and back more than two strides or four steps with front legs

- Major disobedience or schooling

- Failure to start lope prior to and same in Pattern 1

- Four or more simple lead changes and/or failures to change leads (except for Level 1 and Recreational classes)

- Failure to start legs beyond 30 feet of designated area in Patterns 2, 3, 4, 5 and Level 1 Western Riding Patterns 1, 2, and 4 (except for Level 1 classes)

- Duration of more than 1:00 hour

- Hitting or soiling leg

- Out of lead more than one stride either side of the center point and between markers

- Splitting the leg (leg between two front or two hind feet) at the lope

- Hind legs skipping or coming together during lead change

3 Point Penalties:

- Not performing the specified gait (lop or lope) or not stopping when called for the pattern, with 10 feet (3 meters) or the designated area

- Simple change of leads

- Out of lead at or before the marker prior to the designated change area or out of lead at or after the marker after the designated change area

- Additional lead changes anywhere in pattern (except when correcting an extra change or incorrect lead)

- Pattern 1 and 3: failure to start the lope within 30 feet (9 meters) after crossing the leg at the leg

- Break of gait at walk or lope for more than two strides

- Break of gait at the stop

5 Point Penalties:

- Out of lead beyond the next designated change area (note: failures to change, including cross-cantering, two consecutive failures to change would result in two five point penalties.)

- Disobedience (including kicking out, biting, bucking and rearing)

- Holding saddle with either hand

- Use of either hand to hold lead or reins

Disqualification (DQ) or 0 Score:

- Dangerous equipment

- Verbal Abuse

- Off Course

- Knocking over markers

- Major refusal - stop and back more than two strides or four steps with front legs

- Major disobedience or schooling

- Failure to start legs prior to end of Pattern 1

- Four or more simple lead changes and/or failures to change leads (except for Level 1 and Rookie classes)

- Failure to start lope beyond 30 feet of designated area in Patterns 2, 3, 4, 5 and Level 1 Western Riding Patterns 1, 2, and 4 (except for Level 1 classes)

- Crossing of more than 1/4 turn

Each Penalties team is scored between 0-100 points and a consistency bonus is given with a score of 70 points
